This is your Sample Ballot for the March 10, 2026, City of Mary Esther Municipal Election.

- Only City of Mary Esther residents registered to vote on or before February 9, 2026, are eligible to vote in this election.
- If you have moved since you last voted, please check with the Supervisor of Elections Office to verify if you are still eligible for this city election.
- **Move your polling place to your living room.** Request your ballot by contacting the Supervisor of Elections office via telephone, email, mail, in person or by visiting our website. According to Florida Law, all Vote-By-Mail requests expire after each General Election. That means that at the end of 2024 all existing requests we had on file expired. To continue voting by mail in 2026, voters may need to renew their request. Vote-By-Mail ballots must be returned to the Supervisor of Elections Office by 7pm on Election Day in order to be counted. The last day to request a ballot is February 26, 2026.
- **Early voting** will be held Monday, March 2 – Friday, March 6, at the Supervisor of Elections Offices in Crestview and Shalimar. Early Voting hours of operation are 8:30 am – 4:30 pm.
- Your polling place (see reverse) for registered city residents will be open from 7am to 7pm on March 10, 2026, Election Day.
