The EI-ISAC is a national organization that created a partnership between the Center for Internet Security (CIS), Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA), and the Election Infrastructure Subsector Government Coordinating Council (GCC).

Supervisor Lux has reaffirmed his commitment to uphold the mission of the EI-ISAC and to advance the security of elections critical infrastructure through this innovative and supportive community.

As Chairperson, Supervisor Lux's responsibilities will include:

- Presiding over Executive Committee meetings
- Creating Executive Committee sub-committees to research/investigate and make recommendations to the Executive Committee on behalf of the EI-ISAC Membership.

Since 1999, Supervisor Lux served in the Okaloosa County elections office in various capacities until he was elected Supervisor of Elections in 2008. He is honored to now have the additional distinction of serving the national elections community as the EI-ISAC Chairperson.

"It is an honor and a privilege to be entrusted by both state and local elections professionals from across our nation to serve the broader community at large during this time of preparation for mid-term elections while facing our unique challenges head-on," says Paul Lux, Supervisor of Elections.
